

The Wilson Tobs are seeking a talented, hard working, team player to fill the position of Radio Broadcaster/Public Relations Manager for the 2010 season. The Wilson Tobs are the 2005 Organization of the Year of the Coastal Plain League, a collegiate summer league sanctioned by Major League Baseball. The Tobs play 29 home games at Historic Fleming Stadium, a Wilson landmark.

The successful candidate will be responsible for providing the play-by-play for all 57 Tobs' 2010 games and any Tobs playoff games. All Tobs' games are broadcast live on WUBN 106.9 FM and via the Internet. The home broadcasts are also simulcast on the Coastal Plain League's WebPass subscription service.

This position is also responsible for the following:

- Maintenance of team-owned broadcasting equipment;
- Assisting in some radio advertising sales and overseeing commercial production;
- Maintaining the press box and other media accommodations at home games;
- Preparing game notes and stat packs for media, coaches and scouts at home games;
- Preparing roster insert for scorecard at home games;
- Coordinating all player and mascot appearances;
- Overseeing all postgame reports, including: game recap, box scores and press releases that are distributed to media outlets, Internet sites and the league office;
- Other duties as assigned

In addition to these duties, numerous projects and tasks will surface that require all staff members to "pitch in" and get them done. We have a philosophy that no one, from the general manager down to the batboys, is ever allowed to say, "That's not my job." Even in this position, the successful candidate will assist in the set up of the stadium for the season and on game days, the creation and implementation of promotional nights, grassroots community marketing, and administrative assistance among other operational tasks. As with all organizations at this level, the successful candidate will be expected work hard for a significant amount of hours during the summer, for very little compensation. Realistically, this type of position is not for everyone, only those select individuals who are committed to a career in sports.

The ideal candidate should be a college graduate with some experience broadcasting play-by-play for baseball or softball in a solo environment (i.e. no color analyst). We are seeking a team player with a strong work ethic and a commitment to rolling up their sleeves and doing whatever it takes to get their foot in the door and acquire the skills to be successful in this field.

The start date for this position is negotiable, but should be around March 15 and the end date will be September 1.
